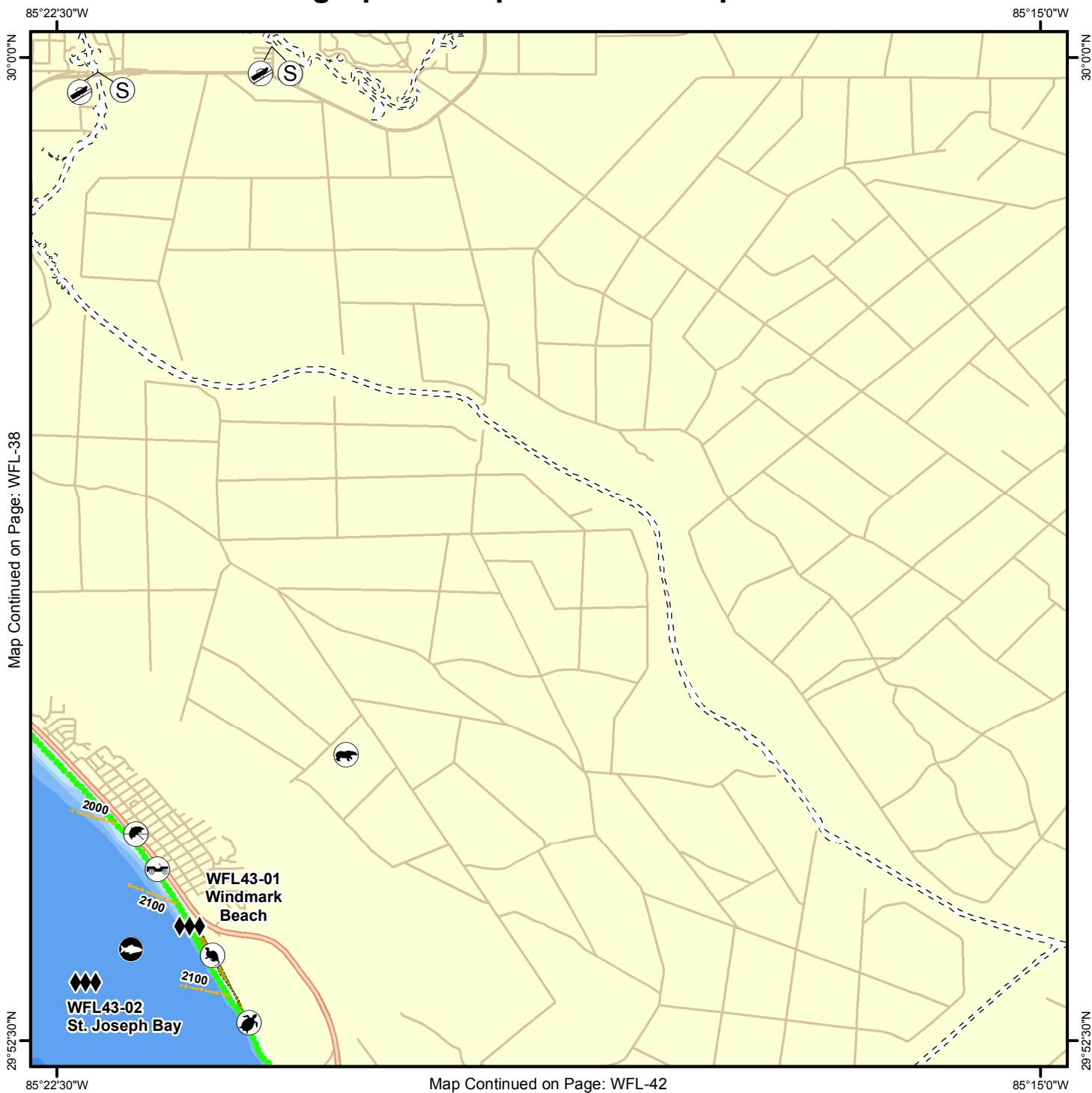


Geographic Response Plan Map: WFL-43
